# WyGar Lubrication Warranty

## 1. Warranty Statement

WyGar Industries Ltd. stands behind the integrity and performance of every drop of reconditioned lubricant we process. Our finished products are engineered, tested, and internally certified under strict quality control standards to meet or exceed the specifications of the original lubricant class. If an equipment failure occurs as a direct result of the quality of WyGar reconditioned lubricants, the coverage conditions herein are met, and the equipment failure is not a result of the limitations herein, then WyGar Industries Ltd. will cover the full cost of the affected component(s), no questions asked.

## 2. Coverage Conditions

To qualify under the WyGar Lubrication Warranty, the following conditions must be met:

- The lubricant in question must have been supplied, reconditioned, or certified by WyGar Industries Ltd.
- The subject equipment and any other equipment used in conjunction with the subject equipment must have been maintained in accordance with manufacturer-recommended service intervals and procedures.
- Used oil analysis results must be available for the previous six (6) months of operation to establish lubricant condition and maintenance practices.
- Equipment operating conditions must not have been abnormal or outside of the OEM's design parameters (e.g., overheating, contamination, excessive loads, coolant leaks, etc.).
- ECU/ECM or equivalent operational data must be made available for review.
- WyGar Industries Ltd. must be granted the opportunity to inspect both the equipment and the lubricant sample to verify the cause of failure. Root cause failure analysis may be requested.

## 3. Warranty Limitations

This warranty applies exclusively to equipment failures proven to be caused by lubricant quality or contamination attributable to WyGar Industries Ltd. WyGar Industries Ltd. is not responsible for failures resulting from mechanical defects, improper filtration, unauthorized blending, contamination introduced during handling or storage by the end user, or, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any other cause not attributable to WyGar Industries Ltd. Wygar Industries Ltd. will not be responsible for any labour-related costs for component replacement or any downtime related to equipment availability.

## 4. Quality Assurance and Standards



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WyGar Industries Ltd. adheres to rigorous used oil analysis testing procedures from our own independent laboratory. Wygar lubricant handling policies and procedures are industry-leading and constantly monitored. This includes but is not limited to proprietary base oil repair, additive technology variations, and viscosity correction.

## **5. Claim Process**

In the rare event of a suspected lubricant-related failure, notify WyGar Industries Ltd. immediately with full details. Provide used oil analysis from the failed component and 6 months history, maintenance history, and ECU/ECM data. Our technical specialists will assess the data and confirm lubricant condition. If lubricant quality is deemed to be the root cause, the coverage conditions herein are met, and the equipment failure is not a result of the limitations herein, then WyGar Industries Ltd. will cover the full replacement cost of the failed component.
